

Membership in the Tri-City Curling Club

- Membership in the Tri-City Curling Club is open to all residents of Wisconsin Rapids, Port Edwards, Nekoosa and surrounding areas.
- The curling season typically runs from November through March.
- Members can play in multiple leagues and use the club for practice anytime there are no scheduled events.
- As a volunteer managed and operated club, members are expected to participate in and support the club activities as much as their schedules will permit. Significant activities include:

 - Wednesday Night – Learn to Curl and Rookie League. A three week Learn to Curl program is followed up with a several weeks of games involving the participants. Those who choose can join in other league opportunities
 - Thursday Night Men’s Dinner League – A long running league that features nine teams Eight teams play games each week and the ninth team prepares an evening meal for all
